Mr. Ramiccio is a senior Department of the Army Civilian leading civilian career development and talent management activities on behalf of the Army Medical Department Civilian Corps. Mr. Ramiccio leverages 43 years of combined federal service to champion the career management and education and training opportunities in support of 5500 medical career field civilian professionals. A graduate of the prestigious Harvard Kennedy School and Naval War College, Mr. Ramiccio has led high-performing teams in tactical, operational, and strategic roles. He served an interagency broadening assignment as the Deputy Director, Office of Agency Management and Budget, for the

Veterans Employment and Training Services Agency, U.S. Department of Labor and served in key leadership roles at MEDCOM including, creator/Director of the military-civilian trauma training partnerships program, Assistant Deputy Chief of Staff for Operations, Plans, and Training (G-3/5/7), and Deputy Special Assistant to the Surgeon General for Military Health System Governance. He is the former Chief, Flight Systems Branch/Senior Aeromedical Research Pilot at the Army Aeromedical Research Laboratory where he provided expert aviation & aeromedical policy advice while leading research teams that helped transform the aviation science and technology landscape.

Mr. Ramiccio is a retired Army aviator having amassed 4200 flight hours over 26 years of aviation service. His deployments include Operation Joint Endeavor, Operation Joint Guard, and Operation Able Sentry (1995-1998). He has served in key leadership and staff roles in the 82D Airborne Division, 1st Armor Division, Training & Doctrine Command, and III Corps, and Medical Research and Development Command.

Mr. Ramiccio holds a master's degree in National Security and Strategic Studies from the U.S. Naval War College, with a Graduate Certificate in Ethics & Emerging Military Technologies, and a Bachelor of Science degree in Professional Aeronautics from Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University. He is a Harvard Senior Executive Fellow and member of the American College of Healthcare Executives.
